Zebulon Montgomery Pike III's retirement



At the end of the of March, Zebulon Montgomery Pike III will be retiring from the US Navy in San Diego, CA after 27 years of eloquent service to our country.

Following in his ancestors' footsteps Pike ascended to the rank of Senior Chief Petty Officer and retired with full military honors.

Zeb is a PNHTA LIFE member and is seen here with fellow life members, his cousin Brian Pike and his uncle Clifford Pike.

Zeb is the only person now named Zebulon Montgomery Pike and third oldest dependent of General Pike. His Granduncle and Great-Granduncle were named Zebulon Montgomery Pike.

His uncle Clifford Pike is the oldest living dependent of the explorer. His cousin Brian Pike is the oldest, living, direct line decedent. They are 3x and 4x great nephews of ZMPike.
