

The name Zebulon Montgomery (Monty) Pike of the 1800's was revived by the Pike family. Zebulon Montgomery Pike was born on January 14, 1900, in Morrison, Colorado to Charles and Fannie, We will look at more of the Pike genealogy in a future Newsletters.

We are going to focus on the sons of this same Monty Pike Sr. family (see top of chart), namely the first two of four brothers who achieved so much in their lifes. Monty Jr., and Edward.

We are proud of their grand uncle the explorer ZM Pike, for whom we are promoting a national trail and particularly of these two brothers. Monty Jr is the closest living relative to the explorer, a WW2 hero and was a Pike Assoc. vice president and Edward's son Brian is one of our current vice presidents. (Again see the chart above.)
