

FEASIBILITY REPORT-

On July 15, 2020 Brian Pike, Linda Balough and Harv met with Aaron Mahr and his NPS Feasibility Study team on the phone. We were introduced to the Feasibility Study team. Lillis Urban is the experienced Principle NPS Planner for the Pike Feasibility Study. There is a NPS Historian and GIS Specialist (map specialist) on the team. Aaron went over the process & outlined responsibilities. It is important to work cooperatively which was agreed to. Scoping meetings (public meetings) are being planned and may be done electronically if not in person. Brian, Linda and I were impressed with the quality of people being brought to the Feasibility Study process. Again we must add that the study will take time.

ASSOCIATION PLAN FOR DESIGNATION

Making People Aware and Requesting their comments

We made County Commissioners, Mayors, Chambers of Commerce, and Historical/ Preservation/ Heritage Societies (950 of them) aware that the feasibility study is being conducted using MailChimp. A second email was sent to them requesting their comments and suggestions.

These letters expressed the economic, educational, recreational, and historic preservation advantages brought to communities by a national trail. We also emphasized that the modern NPS route likely will use public roads/trails and will not involve private property.

You should know that there are a number of private property individuals who enjoy showing us what they believe are Pike sites. Many explain how the lay of the land closely matches Pike's Journal descriptions. **Communication and Promotion**

The Association plan for passage of the Congressional designation bill calls for keeping people informed and getting their support.

Promotional items have been purchased including 'I Hiked the Pike' map, and 'I Like Pike' (Campaign buttons).

We continue to receive positive and helpful responses when we recontact many of the 950. Clerks are particularly helpful and enthusiastic. Many applaud our effort and will do what is needed to designate the
